## ELR (Experiential Learning Requirement) Questions?

#### Q: Can I do an internship over winter break?

**A:** Although winter break is an excellent opportunity to gain experience and network, all internship opportunities require a minimum of six consecutive weeks and at least 70 hours. Winter break does not allow enough time to meet the six-week requirement. Internships over winter break <u>do not qualify</u> for ELR credit. However, winter break is an ideal time to consider a study abroad experience which does not require six weeks. See the <u>Stetson WORLD</u> website to explore these.

#### Q: I plan to study abroad in Innsbruck next summer. Can I count that as an ELR?

**A:** All Stetson faculty-led study abroad trips can count as an ELR. Stetson's study abroad options can be found through this link: <u>STUDY ABROAD</u>. Non-Stetson study abroad opportunities may also count toward ELR. Please discuss your plans with the ELR office at <u>sobaelr@stetson.edu</u> prior to departure.

#### Q: I heard I could join Green, White, and You to earn ELR credit. Is this true?

**A:** To earn ELR credit for Green, White, and You, you must hold a position of VP or higher for a minimum of two consecutive semesters. Although membership is not enough to earn ELR, joining GW&Y is a great experience and an excellent addition to your resume.

# Q: I'm doing a full-time Non-Academic Internship with an insurance company this summer. It'll last for 12 weeks. Can I count this as two separate Non-Academic Internships?

**A:** Because the internship is assigned with a set of goals, responsibilities, and duties, this will count as one internship experience. You can intern with the same company the following summer, but you must be assigned a new set of goals, responsibilities, and duties. (Most internships exceed the minimum requirements.)

### Q: I'm attending Stetson University but am not a US resident. Can I have an ELR waived?

**A:** If you attend Stetson University on an <u>F-1 Visa</u>, you qualify to have one ELR waived. Log into the <u>ELR Canvas</u> course and navigate to "F-1 Visa ELR Credit". Take the quiz, entering "yes" as your answer.

# Q: I work at Publix. Can I count my job as a Non-Academic Internship or Full-Time Employment to earn ELR credit?

**A:** In most cases, student jobs do not meet the depth of responsibilities required for professional experience. Additionally, for full-time employment to satisfy ELR credit, the job must be of a professional nature, and you must be in the position for a minimum of two consecutive years. Please verify eligibility with the ELR office at <u>sobaelr@stetson.edu</u>.

# Q: My friend told me to join the JJ Master Center Professionalism Certificate Program to get ELR credit. Does this qualify?

**A:** Yes, if you also complete a 10-hour micro-internship. Once you participate in the program, you must complete a micro-internship at any point prior to graduation to receive ELR credit for the program. The program requires attendance at all meetings and completion of all deliverables. Micro-internship opportunities can be arranged on your own or found through <u>Parker Dewey</u>. The <u>Career Success</u> office can assist with this process. Click <u>HERE</u> to apply.

# Q: I'm starting a Student Employment position in the fall. Can I use Student Employment as an ELR experience?

**A:** Possibly. <u>Some</u> Student Employment positions can qualify for ELR credit. Your Student Employment position must be pre-approved using the form found on the ELR <u>Canvas</u> page. Navigate to "Student Employment" and find the "Student Employment Step 1: Pre-Approval Form". Please submit this form and wait for approval before proceeding with additional documents.

### Q: I recently joined a fraternity. Can I count my involvement as an ELR?

**A:** Possibly. ELR credit for involvement in Greek Life requires a minimum of a board member position. In addition, not all Greek Life board member positions qualify for ELR credit. ELR credit for Greek Life must be pre-approved using the form found on the ELR <u>Canvas</u> page. Navigate to "Significant Leadership" and find the "Significant Leadership Step 1: Pre-Approval Form". Please submit this form and wait for approval before proceeding with additional documents.

#### Q: I recently participated in VITA and completed the needed sessions. Does this count as an ELR?

**A:** Successfully participating in VITA can count as an ELR when coupled with a program reflection and submitting a Career Success-approved resume. Upload your resume through HatterJobs to start the editing process. Once approved, upload your final resume into the ELR <u>Canvas course</u>. To complete the program reflection, view the VITA reflection requirements in the ELR Canvas course.

#### Q: I was recently offered a paid summer internship. Can a paid internship qualify as an ELR?

**A:** Yes, internship opportunities may be paid or unpaid but must meet our guidelines about career/educational alignment, minimum weeks, and minimum hours.

# Q: I am not a typical college student. I served four years in the military and am coming to Stetson to earn my degree. Do I have to complete the Experiential Learning Requirement with my background?

**A:** As a "non-traditional" student, your military service can give you credit for ELR with four-years' service. Please email a copy of your DD 214 to the ELR office at sobaelr@stetson.edu, and your ELRs will be satisfied.

Other experiences in the "non-traditional student" category are those who have spent more than two years working in a professional/ career position or made a living by owning and operating a functioning, ongoing business for at least two years.
