



How to Fund Your Brass and Percussion Camp Experience: A Guide for Students and Parents

Attending a summer program like the Stetson Brass and Percussion Camp, not only helps student's development their music and playing abilities, but also advances one's confidence, responsibility, courage, and relationship/friendship building skills. If you need help paying for camp, I urge you to consider the funding sources and ideas below.

FINANCIAL RESOURCES TO EXPLORE

High Schools: Some high schools and band boosters offer scholarships to students needing financial help for summer music programs. Ask your music teacher if there are such scholarships available. Also ask your guidance counselor if they might know of any opportunities.

Youth Orchestras: If you play in a youth orchestra, ask the organization if there are any scholarship funds available for summer music programs.

Arts Councils: Cities and metropolitan areas can support young artists through their own Community Arts Councils. Search municipal websites for information about grants, proposal requirements, and deadlines.

Crowdfunding: Webpages such as GoFundMe are an efficient way to raise money. Make sure you clearly express your goals and describe how you will use the money. Say something personal and make sure to send a thank you if they sponsor you!

Place of Worship: Ask your worship leadership about possible support. Leadership may be willing to mention to the worship community you are looking for sponsorship to attend a summer music camp.

Sponsorships: Write letters to everyone you and your parents know asking for sponsorship. Explain what the Stetson Brass and Percussion Camp is, why you want to go, and the benefits of attending. Personalize the letter and make sure to send a thank you if they sponsor you.

Scholarships: This might be more difficulty to attain but worth a shot. Search for music high school scholarships, summer camp scholarships, summer music camp scholarships, etc.
